International Council of Museums (ICOM) was created in 1946 by and for museum professionals. It has 115 National Committees and 30 International Committees dedicated to various museum specialties. University Museum and Collections (UMAC) of ICOM was founded in 2001 to help preserve and provide access to this significant part of national and international heritage with its many unique and unusual collections among all those working in, or associated with, academic museums, galleries and collections (including herbaria and botanical gardens).

国际博物馆协会成立于 1946 年，在 115 个国家建立国家委员会，下设 30 个国际专业委员会。国际博协大学博物馆与藏品委员会成立于 2001 年，旨在帮助保护散落在各个大学博物馆、美术馆、植物园及标本园中的多种藏品。这些机构及其藏品是国家 and 国际遗产的重要组成部分。



National Educational Alliance of University and College Museums (NEAUCM) was founded in May 2012, with a total of 95 museum members. It aims to become the platform for university museums and will actively promote the museums' deep cooperation and resource sharing, making the museums unleash all educational potentials. University museums are encouraged to become the influential elements of university culture and city civilization.

全国高校博物馆育人联盟于 2012 年 5 月在上海成立，现拥有会员单位 95 家，旨在成为各高校博物馆沟通交流的平台和纽带，积极推动各馆的深度合作和资源共享，使得高校博物馆充分发挥其育人功能，创造文化育人的新模式，成为大学文化传承、提升城市文明的重要力量。



Shanghai Educational Alliance of University and College Museums (SEAUCM) is a non-profit organization founded voluntarily by Shanghai university museums. Its purpose is to promote China's cultural prosperity, to achieve resources integration within the Alliance, and to explore how university museums can best serve teaching, research, social service and cultural inheritance.

上海市高校博物馆育人联盟是由上海高校博物馆自愿发起成立的非营利性组织，宗旨是为推动我国文化大发展大繁荣，促进上海公共文化服务体系建设，在市委宣传部、市教卫工作党委、市教委的领导下，在市教卫工作党委的具体指导下，联合上海高校博物馆，组织开展文化育人活动，实现联盟内的资源整合，协调发展，共同提高，更好地发挥高校博物馆在人才培养、科学研究、社会服务和文化传承创新等方面的职能。



Qian Xuesen Library & Museum of Shanghai Jiao Tong University (QLM-SJTU) was first open to the public on December 11, 2011. As a memorial museum dedicated to the scientist Dr. Qian Xuesen, it houses a collection of nearly 61,000 pieces of artifacts, manuscripts, objects and archives of Dr. Qian. QLM has permanent exhibits themed on Dr. Qian's life and legacy and has attracted nearly 1.1 million visitors so far.

上海交通大学钱学森图书馆建成于 2011 年 12 月 11 日，是著名科学家钱学森的纪念馆，馆内收藏保存着 6.1 万余件钱学森珍贵文献、手稿、照片和实物，基本陈列为“人民科学家钱学森”主题展览。该馆是全国爱国主义教育示范基地、全国科普教育基地。开馆以来，近 110 万人次进馆参观。

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Message from UMAC President

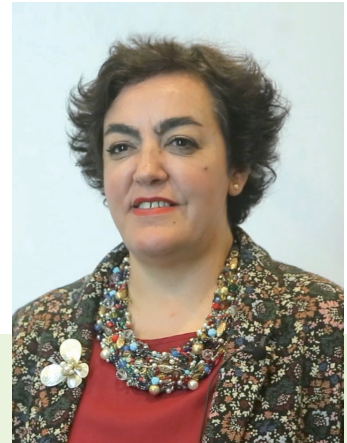
This is the second edition of the University Museums Training Week Shanghai (UMTWS), jointly organized by UMAC – the International Committee of ICOM for University Museums and Collections – and the Qian Xuesen Library and Museum, Shanghai Jiao Tong University (QLM-SJTU).

This year's program is outstanding. The diversity and quality of speakers, combined with the multilayered approach of talks, debates, group work and field visits, will certainly bring new perspectives on contemporary university museums, in China and elsewhere. I am deeply grateful to the UMAC-QLM Joint Committee for their efforts towards the program, all the speakers and contributors to make this year's training program happen.

Apart from fruitful exchanges that always happen when professionals meet and share experiences, from UMAC's perspective the UMTWS has two main objectives. The first, more general, has to do with the role played by professional development in UMAC's global strategy. Anywhere in the world – from China to Brazil, and from the USA to Finland – highly trained university museum professionals are a top priority for UMAC.

The second objective is to increase international studies and visibility of Chinese university museums. China has outstanding university museums, collections and heritage in the arts, sciences and humanities. They are completely prepared to compete with the most important cultural attractions, in Shanghai and elsewhere in China. However, Chinese university museums are still poorly known outside the borders of China.

UMAC is committed to bringing Chinese university museums increasingly into the international sphere, particularly among the ICOM and UMAC communities. The number of UMAC members in China is growing, and so is the number of entries from China in the UMAC World Database of University Museums. Chinese authors are beginning to appear in our journal UMACJ. Several Chinese university museum professionals will participate in our Annual Conference in Miami, Florida, next June, and also in other university museums network meetings in Europe. In 2019, UMAC will meet in Kyoto, Japan, and I am sure we will have the largest participation ever from China.



Geographically speaking, every university museum has a double dimension. It is certainly local because it results from local demands, people, institutions and community dynamics. It materializes specific research, teaching or outreach activities of a given university. However, in its almost 1,000-year history, the university has always been, and is today more than ever, a global institution.

Universities were global even before the idea of nation existed. The University of Louvain is older than Belgium, the University of Padua is older than Italy, the University of Tartu is older than Estonia, and several German universities – like Heidelberg or Göttingen – are much older than Germany, just to give a few European examples. For centuries, students, researchers, professors, books, and also collections, have circulated across countries, continents, and oceans, from North to South, from East to West, and back.

This global dimension is not always visible in our university museums. Typically, the local prevails and there are reasons for that. First, the local is an easier concept to approach. Second, identity and memory require a local, regional or national perspective. As a result, the “local” dimension often dominates our approaches to collections, exhibitions and educational programs.

However, the global university in a global society compels us to go beyond local approaches. How can contemporary university museums make the global more visible in their activities? How can they be instruments of the “global university”? Perhaps even more importantly, how can they be tools for our understanding of present changing “global societies”? How can they contribute to actively promoting universal values of knowledge and creativity?

I think these are challenges for university museums everywhere, but especially in China where universities are increasingly becoming crucial players in the global higher education sector and where university museums are growing like nowhere else in the world. Chinese universities are global universities and their museums global museums.

UMAC主席致辞

由国际博协大学博物馆与藏品委员会、全国高校博物馆育人联盟、上海市高校博物馆育人联盟、上海交通大学钱学森图书馆联合举办的 2018 高校博物馆国际培训班将于 2018 年 4 月在上海开班。该培训班是继 2017 高校博物馆国际培训班之后的第二届国际培训班。今年的培训形式丰富、内容精彩，授课老师来自不同的国家、有着丰富的大学博物馆研究及管理经验。辩论、会谈、授课、小组工作和实地考察等多层次、多角度的讨论方式也必将为中国和其他地区的当代大学博物馆带来全新的视角。十分感谢项目工作组为本次培训班做出的辛勤努力，也非常感谢所有的授课教师及关心和帮助此次培训班的同仁们所付出的时间和精力。

高校博物馆国际培训班为专业人士提供了一个分享和交流的重要平台。除此之外，从国际博协大学博物馆与藏品委员会 (UMAC) 的角度，在中国举办国际培训班主要有两个目标：第一，UMAC 的全球发展战略注重高校博物馆的人员培训，从中国到巴西，从美国到芬兰，对世界范围内的高校博物馆工作人员进行专业培训是 UMAC 的重点工作。第二，增加中国大学博物馆在世界范围内的显示度和知名度。中国拥有非常优秀的大学博物馆、藏品和艺术人文及科学类的各类文化遗产，他们完全有跟世界其他大学博物馆同台竞争的实力。可惜的是，中国的大学博物馆在世界范围内的发声很少。

UMAC 一直致力于增加中国的大学博物馆在国际社会的知名度，尤其是在国际博协和 UMAC 体系中的显示度。UMAC 中国大学博物馆的会员单位数量在增加，也有更多中国学者在 UMACJ 杂志上投稿，一些中国大学博物馆的工作人员也将参与今年 6 月在迈阿密举行的 UMAC 年度会议及欧洲有关大学博物馆的学术会议。2019 年，UMAC 会在日本京都举行年会，我期待更多中国大学博物馆的从业及研究人员参会。

每个大学博物馆都有一个地理意义上的双重属性。首先，大学博物馆肯定有“当地性”，因为它的存在由当地的人员构成、有当地的实际需求、有当地的机构特征，也具象化了当地大学的研究、教学和社会需求。但是，在大学博物馆一千多年的发展历程中，尤其是当下，大学博物馆更应该有“世界性”。

大学的“世界性”甚至早于国家的地缘概念。举几个欧洲的例子：鲁汶大学的历史长于比利时的历史，帕多瓦大学在意大利建国之前就已存在，塔尔图大学比爱沙尼亚拥有更久远的历史，德国的海德堡大学和哥廷根大学都比现代德国的历史长。几个世纪以来，学生、教师、研究人员、书籍和藏品，从人到物，都曾跨越千山万水、辗转南北西东，实现世界范围内的流动。但是大学的“世界性”却并不一定体现在大学博物馆上。通常情况下，大学博物馆的“当地性”远超“世界性”，原因有二：第一，大学博物馆总是更能接触到当地的资源；第二，身份认同和记忆保存总是更容易从当地的、地区的或者是国家的层面入手。因此，大学博物馆的“当地性”成为指导藏品、展览和教育活动的核心理念。

大学一直存在于“世界性”的环境中。“世界性”的大学促使大学博物馆要超越“当地性”的工作模式。当代的大学博物馆如何在他们的日常活动中体现更多“世界性”的特点？如何助力大学成为“世界性”的大学？更为重要的是，大学博物馆如何帮助构造“全球命运共同体”？如何积极推动创新和知识普及？

全球的大学博物馆都面临上述问题，但中国大学博物馆面临的挑战尤其突出。中国的大学在世界大学中扮演越来越重要的角色，中国新建大学博物馆的数量也是其他国家无可比拟的。中国的大学是“世界性”的大学，因此他们的博物馆也必然是“世界性”的博物馆。

General introduction

The university museum landscape is going through considerable changes worldwide. New university museums are being created and old ones are being restructured and reorganized. Many universities are increasingly looking at museums, collections and heritage as important tools to implement their educational and cultural strategy, as well as meaningful windows between academia and society. For the University Museums Training Week Shanghai 2018 (UMTWS 2018), UMAC-ICOM and the Qian Xuesen Library and Museum (QLM-SJTU) have prepared a broad program that goes deep into what it means to be a university museum today, through a combination of case-studies (Chinese and international), field visits, debates and a contemporary bibliography. Thanks to the sponsorship by China's NEAUCM and SEAUCM, this training program intends to explore the following questions: What are the important issues to be considered in strategic planning, management and policies? What role can collections, exhibitions and educational programs play? What works and what doesn't – for the museum, the university, and the community?

Goals and Prioritization: Strategic Planning in University Museums

Training will be conducted as a planning workshop where each participant will have developed a draft of a master plan for their own university museum at the end of the session. All participants are asked to bring copies of any existing documents (mission statement, governance structure, master plan, collection policy) in English and in language of origin.

项目介绍

全世界的大学博物馆都在发生着深刻的变化，旧馆在进行更新改造，新馆也日益增多。越来越多的大学意识到校园里的博物馆、藏品和其他一切文化遗产是服务于其教育及文化战略的重要工具，也是连接学术和社会的重要窗口。

为进一步提升高校博物馆从业人员专业素养，拓展国际视野，加强国际合作与交流，在国际博协的指导下，全国高校博物馆育人联盟、国际博协大学博物馆与藏品委员会、上海市高校博物馆育人联盟、上海交通大学钱学森图书馆于2018年4月11日-20日在上海举办2018高校博物馆国际培训班。该培训班是继2017年首届高校博物馆国际培训班之后的第二届高校博物馆国际培训班。在为期10天的时间里，国内外的知名博物馆专家将共同为来自清华大学、浙江大学、香港中文大学等26所高校的29名博物馆从业人员集中授课。

本次培训班以“大学博物馆：建设与运营（Goals and Prioritization: Strategic Planning in University Museums）”为主题，通过知识讲授、小组讨论、案例分析、实地参观和总结分享等多种形式，兼顾理论知识与实务工作，融通中外大学博物馆建设与发展经验，力求让学员进一步清晰理解大学博物馆与大学的关系以及大学博物馆的筹建、藏品、展览、教育与可持续发展等关键问题。希望通过本次培训，使学员们能够有所收获，并以全新的视角和姿态，用行动去推动大学博物馆的发展。

Andrew Simpson Macquarie University

Andrew Simpson is an Honorary Fellow in the Department of Ancient History, Macquarie University. He has a background in Australian higher education as an academic delivering undergraduate and postgraduate museum studies programs and as a professional staff responsible for university museums and collections. He holds a leadership role with CAUMAC (the Council of Australian University Museums and Collections, a national network of Museums Australia) and a Board role with UMAC (an International Committee of the International Council of Museums). He was the initial chair of Museums Australia's Professional Development Committee responsible for devising national strategies for improving sector skills. He is currently a consultant working on a variety of cultural and higher educational projects including the development of institutional policies and strategies. Andrew has published widely on the subject of university museums and collections and is currently leading a working group that is re-evaluating the University Museums and Collections Journal.



Andrew Simpson 博士是澳大利亚麦考瑞大学古代史系荣誉研究员，在澳大利亚高等教育机构中开展博物馆学的本科及研究生教学工作，并负责高校博物馆及藏品的相关工作。Simpson 博士在澳大利亚大学博物馆与藏品委员会中担任领导职务，也是国际博协大学博物馆及藏品委员会理事，曾任澳大利亚博物馆协会专业发展委员会首任主席，负责制定提升行业能力的国家战略。目前，他正从事各类文化及高等教育项目的咨询工作，包括制定机构政策和规划等。Simpson 博士发表了诸多高校藏品专业的文章，也在负责《高校博物馆与藏品》期刊的重审工作。

Barbara Rothermel Lynchburg College

Barbara Rothermel is Director of the Daura Gallery and Associate Professor of Museum Studies at Lynchburg College, Virginia. Dr. Rothermel holds a BA in art and cultural history with honors from Hood College, a Masters in Liberal Studies, museum studies emphasis, with a concentration in art history from the University of Oklahoma, and a PhD in museum studies from the University of Leicester, where her dissertation concerns the university art museum as a catalyst for interdisciplinary faculty collaboration. Dr. Rothermel is vice-president of the University Museums and Collections of the International Council of Museums (ICOM-UMAC), and for 14 years was a member of the Board of the Association of Academic Museums and Galleries (AAMG).

Kate Arnold-Forster

University of Reading

Kate Arnold-Forster is the Director of University Museums and Special Collections at the University of Reading, where she has led a major program of capital re-development and strategic renewal, including the recent transformation of the Museum of English Rural Life (the UK's leading rural and agricultural museum) and a program of academic engagement for the University's museums and collections. She was Co-Chair of the UK University Museum Group until 2017 and is a former member of the ICOM Committee for University Museums and Collections (UMAC). She is an adviser and trustee to a variety of university museums and libraries and serves on a number of national advisory and strategy reviews for museums in the UK. She was educated at the University of Oxford (MA, Modern History) and is a Fellow of the Museums Association, made MBE by the Queen for services to University Museums and has undertaken extensive research into the UK university museums' sector.

Shanghai History Museum

The Shanghai History Museum was established in 1983 as the "Shanghai History and Artefacts Exhibition Hall". The main museum was closed due to land redevelopment in 1999. In 2016, plans were announced to rebuild the museum at the former Shanghai Race Club house, which had been empty for several years after the Shanghai Art Museum moved out in 2012. The new Shanghai History Museum is scheduled to open to the public March 2018.

Shanghai Museum of Textile and Costume

Shanghai Museum of Textile and Costume was built on the basis of the former Donghua University's Textile History Museum and the Donghua University Costume Museum. It is currently the only museum in China that comprehensively reflects the history and techniques of Chinese textile and costumes. The museum has a building area of more than 6700 square meters and an exhibition area of more than 3000 square meters. The permanent galleries are featured costumes of both ancient and modern China, including various ethnic minorities' costume history and styles.

上海纺织服饰博物馆



上海纺织服饰博物馆是在原东华大学纺织史博物馆和东华大学服饰博物馆基础上新建而成，是目前国内唯一一个全面综合反映中国纺织服饰历史文化和科技知识的博物馆。博物馆以中国纺织服饰发展史和纺织服饰科普教育为主线，兼具科学普及、学术交流、学科教育、科学研究、社会服务的功能，它体现了学术性和科普性的结合、纺织与服饰的融合、少数民族与汉族纺织服饰的综合等特点。展馆现有建筑面积6700多平方米，一期展出面积3000多平方米，共分为科普馆、古代馆、近代馆和少数民族馆四个分馆。
