



POSTER INSTRUCTIONS FOR UMAC KYOTO 2019

- 1. Posters should be in A1 format (594×841 mm; 23.4×33.1 in).
- 2. You must bring in your poster printed; no printer is available at the conference venue.
- 3. Poster Session will be held on Sept 4, in Room C-1. Please bring in your poster to the room during lunchtime, 12:00–13:30.
- 4. Each author is responsible for displaying his/her poster and for removing it immediately after the close of the session, 16:00–16:30. There will be volunteers to help you display and remove your poster. UMAC will not assume responsibility for materials left beyond the time limit.
- 5. Author's names of posters will be placed on poster boards; please find your name and display your poster (pushpins will be available).
- All presentations must be confined to the poster itself. Computer display
 equipment, sound or projection equipment, freestanding or three-dimensional
 displays, demonstrations/experiments, or tables for handout materials are not
 available.

7. Design tips:

- Each poster board measures width: 900 mm, length: 240 mm. Two posters (from different authors) will displayed on one poster board. Your poster should be designed vertically.
- All posters should feature a title, your name, your affiliation, and should credit other contributors, as appropriate.
- Use a crisp, clean design. All lettering should be legible from about 5 feet
 (1.5 m) away. Title lettering should be about 5 to 7.5 cm (2" to 3").

 Subheading lettering should be 1.25 to 2.5 cm high (1/2" to 1"). Text lettering should be approximately 24 points (625 cm or 1/4").
- Displayed materials should be self-explanatory, freeing you for discussion.
