


Fig.2 Online interview with the 2023 UMAC Student Committee

UMuseum App

The UMuseum app is the mobile terminal of university museum database, based on the Worldwide Database of University Museums and Collections. It helps to check information of university museums with smart phone or tablet. We developed it in 2019, the version 2.0 was iterated and launched in February 2021.

We raised the fund (about 4000 euros annually) to maintain the UMuseum app. We maintain the data and server in the app, and the installations in IOS app store and Android google play for access and installation every year from all over the world.

A new version 3.0 will launch in IOS and Android this month (internal testing version 2.9 beta for now).

New figures include:

- 1. **Optimization the user interface** based on in-depth research to boost the appeal, see Fig. 3.
- 2. Addition of interactive content and community function to improve the accessibility.
- 3. Construction of the app background to make the app a dynamic platform.

Supplementary Content

- Participated in the 2022 UMAC Annual Conference in Prague, tried to recruit more colleagues to UMAC and UMAC FUTURES, established contact with 150 more members, and collaborated together to promote cooperation among museums.
- 2. Invited to give a presentation on UMuseum app in Thailand National Science Festival by Thailand National Science Museum, contributing to promote UMAC and build our membership base in Southeastern Asia.
- 3. Collaborated with the Adler Planetarium in the United States on an online exhibition to expand the dimensions of the exhibition, and promote collections in university museums, to some extent.
- 4. As the Chair of UMAC Futures, I organized and hosted multiple lectures and conferences in China.

Plan in the next year

- 1. To rebuild the network of the UMAC FUTURES and recruit new members.
- 2. To maintain the IMAGINATIONS project. To make it more diverse and post the videos onto multiple official social media.
- 3. To coordinate an object-based project to regularly show the collections in university museum community.
- 4. To iterate the UMuseum app to a new version, and do more promotion and publicity work.
- 5. To support and prepare the next Youth Forum/Seminar in Dresden if possible.
